Studio Policy and Agreement (2024-2025)

Schedule: Weekly lesson dates will be given on an attached document.

Academic Year: The academic year consists of 10 months which will be split into two semesters (fall and spring). Students will receive a total of 17 lessons for each semester.

Fall Semester: September-January

Spring Semester: February-June

Summer Months: During the end of June, July and August lessons are scheduled on a week to week basis in accordance with everyone's availability. They are not part of the tuition plan and will be priced per lesson.

Tuition: Tuition may either be paid in full at the start of the semester or divided into 5 monthly installments. Payment will be accepted via Venmo, Zelle, Paypal, cash, or check. Students who choose to pay for the full semester will receive a slightly discounted rate. If paying for the full semester, payment is expected by the first lesson of each semester. If paying by the month, payment is expected by the first lesson of each month. Students who begin after the start of the semester will have the tuition prorated.

Attendance and Cancellation:

Regular weekly lessons are essential to a student's success at the piano. Please be courteous to the teacher by providing at least 24 hours notice of any known absences.

Missed Lessons: Tuition will not be refunded if a student misses a lesson. Instead, a makeup lesson will be offered during a day other than the student's regular weekly lesson.

Makeup Lessons: Make-ups will only be considered for lessons canceled over 24-hours in advance or in the event of emergencies.

All makeup lessons must be completed by the end of the semester. Each student is guaranteed a **maximum of two** makeup lessons per semester. Additional makeup sessions are not guaranteed and will be offered only if the instructor is able.

If the instructor must cancel, a makeup lesson will be guaranteed.

Inclement Weather: Lessons will be given online in the event of inclement weather.

Practice: Daily practice plays a crucial role in a student's development at the piano. Students should be practicing at least 5 days a week in order to ensure that material from the lesson is retained and understood.

Materials: Students will be assigned books and other materials based on their age and level. Students should also have a blank notebook at each lesson where the teacher will write down homework for the week.

Performances Opportunities:

- Studio Recitals: Two studio recitals will be held during the academic year. Recitals are a great opportunity for students to perform for family and friends in a positive and supportive environment. A recital fee of \$20 per student will be charged for each recital. Participation is not mandatory but strongly encouraged.
- NYSSMA: Students have the option of participating in NYSSMA, an annual festival consisting of different musical components.
- ABRSM Exams: The ABRSM exam is great for students who are looking for a more intensive performance evaluation. If interested, please contact the teacher for more information.

Piano lessons require a large commitment from the family and instructor alike. It is my goal to be as flexible and accommodating as possible. However, it is important to understand the necessity of the above policy to ensure that lessons are conducted consistently and effectively.
